
Dear Mr. Ripley,

The City of Mustang has received several complaints from residents in your neighborhood of radio frequency interference with personal electronic devices including home phones, cellular phones and computers. The city's regulations state that an amateur radio tower under 70 feet in height may be erected without a permit only if it is a "receive only" tower.

In our communications with the FCC, they have informed the City of Mustang that they have no mechanism for over-riding municipal ordinances and that the zoning regulations of the local government must always be adhered to when erecting a tower.

Therefore, we are asking you to stop transmitting from your tower immediately to avoid interfering with neighbors' electronic devices. Please contact my office if you need further information.
